- · Confidentiality
 - For authenticity & vulnerability to occur, members must be able to trust that discussions within the group will not be shared outside the group.
- · Respect
 - Group members should never say anything that will embarrass any other members of the group.
- Availability
 - A primary responsibility of the group is to provide care for others within the group. This
 means that group members must be very intentional about making themselves available
 to provide that care.
